Nature High Summer Camp Counselor Application

Dear Potential Camp Counselor,

Thank you for your interest in joining the Nature High Summer Camp team. Our goal is to employ knowledgeable, mature and encouraging counselors! When it comes to managing students, itineraries, activities and projects, you've got it all under control.

NHSC Counselor Responsibilities and Expectations:

- The counselor is the leader of his/her group. Counselor stays with their groups during all activities to provide leadership and minor discipline, such as redirecting a student's focus, calming the talkers or removing a disruptive student from the group for the camp directors to deal with.
- Arrive at the camp by 9 A.M. on the first day of camp for orientation, training and prepare everything needed before the students arrival. (lunch to be provided)
- Provide a 10-15 minute energizer each morning after breakfast to get the students enthused about their activities for the day.
- Use creativity in producing an entertaining event for the participants on the last evening of camp.
- Ensure their groups get to activities on time.
- Enforce 'lights out' on time each night.
- Enforce dorm segregation. Participants/counselors of opposite sexes are not allowed in each other's separate cabins.
- Be familiar with and abide by the Participant's Expectations.

Requirements

- You must have completed one year of college by July 2010.
- Proven leadership experience, especially with youth.
- Energetic person with judgment and decision making skills to provide a positive experience for teenagers.
- Preferably training in CPR and First Aid.

Desired Skills

- Experience with teaching and leading youth or proven maturity to successfully inspire and encourage high school age participants.
- Experience and interest in science, natural resources, agriculture or environmental education activities.

Training and Salary

Staff training is on the first day of camp July 12, 2010. Employment is for 1 week ending on July 17, 2010.

Salary is \$425 for the week.
